for ICORD trainees

Through funding provided by the Rick Hansen Foundation in support of the Blusson Integrated Cures Partnership, ICORD is pleased to support international collaboration for ICORD trainees:

International travel award for ICORD Trainees

- i. This program will support travel costs of ICORD PIs for unique research opportunities (i.e. non-conference travel) of up to \$7,500 CAD;
- ii. Eligible expenses include (but are not limited to): collaborative research projects with international laboratories, participation in knowledge translation activities, and consulting with other research/clinical centres
- iii. ICORD trainees are eligible to apply. In accordance with their supervisors' membership guidelines;
- iv. It is expected that following the travel supported by this program, the ICORD PI will give a seminar to report on activities conducted abroad;
- v. This award must be used within one year of the date of offer;
- vi. A final report is required to be submitted within 90 days of completion of project.
- vii. Applicants will be reviewed by an adjudication committee using a 5-point scale (akin to CIHR, with 5 being the highest score). To maintain a standard of excellence, no applications scoring below 3.5 will be funded.

Applications for the International Travel Award must include:

- 1. A letter from the trainee describing how their activities conducted abroad will i) enhance ICORD's international profile, ii) advance SCI research and education on an international stage, and iii) benefit and inform ICORD trainees, clinicians, and scientists;
- 2. An invitation from the proposed host institute/hospital/centre;
- 3. A project proposal (2 pages) plus a detailed budget for the visit, providing justification for each expense.
- 4. A lay summary (approximately 150-200 words) describing the project, suitable for publication on the ICORD website, social media, etc.
