# **DUE 6 NOV 2023 COPO** Trainee Travel Award

## **Terms of Reference & Instructions**

Funding for ICORD's Trainee Travel Award is made available by the Rick Hansen Foundation. This fund is designed to support travel costs to conferences, meetings, courses, or workshops for ICORD trainees.

#### Eligibility

Full time research trainees (Masters, PhD, or Post-Doctoral Fellows) are eligible to apply for this travel award. Staff members are also encouraged to apply but preference may be given to trainees. The following eligibility criteria apply:

- applicants must be providing an oral or poster presentation at a national or international meeting or conference.
- applicants must be the first author on the accepted abstract.
- if attending a course or workshop, a justification for the impact of attendance on the applicant's training program must be provided.
- the applicant's primary supervisor must be an ICORD Principal Investigator or Investigator.

Applicants may not apply for new funding if they currently hold an ICORD Travel award or received an award in the previous competition.

#### Value of award

The award will support eligible travel costs to a maximum of \$1000 for in-person events or \$300 for virtual events. See UBC Policy on Travel and Related Expenses (www.universitycounsel.ubc.ca/policies/policy83.pdf) for eligible expenses.

### Adjudication of applications

Applications will be reviewed by senior ICORD Administration to verify that the eligibility criteria have been met. Priority will be given to:

- applicants whose work is directly related to ICORD's Strategic Research Priorities (see below).
- applicants who have never previously received an ICORD Trainee Travel Award.
- applicants who have participated in ICORD events or other SCI community involvement\* (e.g. monthly research seminar, ICORD Annual Research Meeting, ICORD trainee meetings, etc).

This priority system will only be invoked if the number of eligible applications exceeds the number of available awards. If applicants under consideration still have equal priority then a draw will be held to determine award allocation.

\* A small number of awards will be heavily weighted on the applicant's ICORD participation.

Travel must take place within a time period of six months before or twelve months after the competition deadline date.

#### Reimbursement

Reimbursements will be provided upon submission of receipts and proof of attendance after the completion of travel. **Awards cannot be transferred to other travel.** Advances will not be issued. Contact Chandelle Coleman for reimbursement instructions (coleman@icord.org)
